the City of Palmer, a duly noticed public hearing was had on May 22, 1970 on
the 1970-71 fiscal year budget of the City, and

for the 1970-71 fiscal year of the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PALMER RESOLVES:

municipal services for the ensuing fiscal year,


Sec. 2. That the 1970-71 budget as presented is hereby adopted and the

and approval.
