A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT ON THE PROJECT KNOWN  
AS INDUSTRIAL PARK WATER EXTENSION - EDA PROJECT  
NO. 07-01-00708

WHEREAS, the City of Palmer did open bids for the installation of a water line to the Palmer Industrial Park on November 9, 1970, and

WHEREAS, the City of Palmer did award the contract to Arctic Pipelines by letter on November 19, 1970; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with paragraph 8 of the Section entitled "Information for Bidders" of the bid specification documents it is required that the successful bidder execute and deliver the contract and bonds required within ten days, and

WHEREAS, the Arctic Pipelines Co. had not delivered the executed contract and bonds after twelve days had elapsed, and


WHEREAS, the Palmer City Manager did on December 1, 1970 in the office of the City Attorney, Burton C. Biss, give notice of award to the second low bidder, B B & S Construction Co.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER:

That the City Manager is instructed to accept the executed contract and proper bonds from B B & S Construction Co. and to execute such contract for the City of Palmer.

Publication of this resolution shall be by posting a copy of the same on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten (10) days.
