RESOLUTION NO. 220

WHEREAS, Alaska Steel Rolling Mills, Inc., an Alaskan Corporation, has requested the consent of the City of Palmer to the location within the City's boundaries of a project generally described as a steel complex, which may include a steel rolling mill, melt plant, scrapyards, machine and maintenance shop, storage areas, fabrication facilities and offices, and

WHEREAS, it appears such project and the project applicant qualify under the provisions of Chapter 61 of Title 44 A.S. and

WHEREAS, the City of Palmer assures the Alaska Industrial Development Authority that it has made and will make provision to meet increased demand upon public facilities that might result from the project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Palmer consents to the location of the proposed project within its boundaries and that a certified copy of this Resolution be supplied to the Alaska Industrial Development Authority in satisfaction of the requirements of Sec. 44.61.160.
