WHEREAS, the paving and landscaping are an integral part of the setting of the Southcentral Pioneer Home, establishing an atmosphere, as well as serving more recognized utilitarian purposes, and

WHEREAS, such construction items are especially necessary in this instance because of the crucial need for dust control, and

WHEREAS, in this particular project, the cost of paving and landscaping will not in fact be saved, if eliminated, because the items as presently designed serve in part as insulation of the building's utility lines and if the paving and landscaping are omitted, some substitute will have to be installed at some additional cost, and

WHEREAS, the programmed funds for such improvements have been eliminated by the Senate Finance Committee,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER THAT:

Such funds be restored and the Southcentral Pioneer Home be completed as a finished, dignified unit as planned, programmed and contracted.
