

CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA
RESOLUTION NO. 224

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF PALMER,
ALASKA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1971, AND
APPROPRIATING MONIES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Chapter VI of the Municipal Charter of the City of Palmer, a duly noticed public hearing was had on June 8, 1971 on the 1971-1972 fiscal year budget of the City and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the budget proposed by the City Manager for the 1971-72 fiscal year of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PALMER RESOLVES:


Sec. 1. That the budget presented to the Council by the City Manager for the fiscal year 1971-72 is adequate and acceptable and meets the needs of all municipal services for the ensuing fiscal year,

Sec. 2. That the 1971-72 budget as presented is hereby adopted and the monies stated herein for the enumerated items are hereby appropriated in the amounts and for the purposes stated in the said budget.


Sec. 3. That the rate of tax levy for the City of Palmer, Alaska for the fiscal year 1971-72 shall be and the same is hereby fixed at four and a half (4½) mills upon each dollar of value of assessed taxable real and personal property. The revenue from this tax levy is to be used for city purposes.

Publication of the Resolution shall be made by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten days following its passage and approval.

Passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Palmer, Alaska, this 8th day of June, 1971.
