## CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA RESOLUTION NO. 229

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FILING OF APPLICATION WITH THE FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR A GRANT FOR SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the United States of America through its Environmental Protection Agency has authorized the making of Grants to public bodies to aid in financing the construction of sewer treatment projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER:

- (1) That William E. Curtis, City Manager, be and is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Palmer, Alaska with the Environmental Protection Agency for a grant to aid in financing the construction of an aerated sewer treatment lagoon with chlorination equipment and miscellaneous appurtenances.
- (2) That William E. Curtis, City Manager, be and is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as necessary, file such documents as necessary, in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed.
