RESOLUTION NUMBER 2 4 5

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY THROUGH ITS PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION TO IMPLEMENT ZONING ON THE LANDS WITHIN A REASONABLE DISTANCE FROM AND OUTSIDE THE EXISTING CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PALMER.

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough, through its Planning and Zoning Commission has the authority to zone all lands within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough, and,

WHEREAS, the only lands within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough presently zoned are those lands within the City Limits of the City of Palmer, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Palmer does, from time to time, annex lands which are contiguous to, but outside of, the City Limits of the City of Palmer, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Palmer does inherit such existing land uses as may be in existence at the time of annexation, and,

WHEREAS, such existing land uses may not be in the best interest of the general public as a whole,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER:

1. That the City Council of the City of Palmer does request the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Planning and Zoning Commission to study the best future land use of the area surrounding the present City Limits of the City of Palmer and,

2. Propose a zoning plan to the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly for adoption by Ordinance at the earliest possible time.

Publication of this Resolution shall be by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall Bulletin Board for a period of ten (10) days following its passage and approval.
