RESOLUTION NO. 252

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE PRESENT CLAXTON DROP ZONE NOT BE DESIGNATED RESTRICTED AIRSPACE, AND BE MOVED.

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA RESOLVES:

THAT WHEREAS, a request has been made to designate the present Claxton, Alaska, drop zone as restricted airspace, and this request has been identified by the Federal Aviation Administration as Airspace Docket No. 72-AL-21, and


WHEREAS, if such request is granted, it will severely restrict general civilian aviation between Palmer and points to the Southwest, including Anchorage, by eliminating the best and safest remaining passage the terrain permits, the others having already been curtailed or restricted.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is respectfully requested that the matter identified as Airspace Docket No. 72-AL-21 be denied in its entirety, and

FURTHER, that drop activities be transferred and confined to locations West of the Anchorage-Fairbanks Highway where space reserves already exist.
